Basic garbage disposal rules ▶ ① Put it out on the morning of collection (by 8:30am) ② Use the designated bags *If these rules are not followed, garbage may not be collected.

Food waste

Paid bags

Collection day
Every week
Monday and Thursday

Drain the water thoroughly, place it in a village designated bag (fee required), and place it in a bucket provided at the garbage station.

Fish bones, vegetable scraps, leftover food, shells, coffee grounds

Fruit peel

Bones (chicken, beef, pork)

Plastic container and packaging

Collection day Every Monday

Commercially available under 45L semi-transparent trash bags (do not use plastic shopping bags)

Only those marked Wash any dirty items and drain the water

* If there is no mark, please dispose of it as non-burnable garbage.

containers for shampoo, detergent, instant ramen, natto, convenience store bento, yogurt, etc.

recyclable waste

Eco bag

Each district will have a semi-transparent bag

Collection day
Every week
Tuesday

Rinse the inside and drain the water

Cans

- aluminum cans
- steel cans
- snack cans
- milk cans

Glass bottles

- beverage bottles
- condiment bottles

* Excluding returnable bottle
* Remove caps and labels

PET bottles

- PET beverage bottles
- PET condiment bottles
- shochu bottles

* Caps and labels are for plastic containers and packaging.

Tray

- white tray
- styrofoam

* Put in a semi-transparent bag or tie with string

Hazardous waste

Collection day Every Tuesday

* Please put batteries in the designated box inside the garbage station.

To prevent damage, please put the product in the original packaging.

Batteries **Lighters** **Fluorescent tube, light bulbs, mercury thermometers**

Other recyclable waste

* Newspapers, magazines, cardboard - tie with string according to category
* Paper cartons: wash, open, dry and tie with string
* Returnable bottle: wash and place in a transparent bag
* Place in a bag specifically for mixed paper (distributed at the town hall counter) or a paper bag with a white lining

Envelopes, postcards, business cards, receipts, copy paper, photos, memo paper, notebooks, slips, wrapping paper

Cardboard **Paper pack**

No aluminum foil inside

1.8L bottles, beer bottles
* Please dispose of at a garbage station or return to the store

Paper container and packaging

Collection day Every Wednesday

Commercially available under 45L semi-transparent trash bags (do not use plastic shopping bags)

Only those marked

* If there is no mark, dispose of in burnable garbage.

Empty cigarette boxes, snack boxes, wrapping paper, alcohol and juice cartons with aluminum inside

Sanitary waste

Disposable diapers Pet sheets

[Put it in a separate burnable garbage bag from other burnable garbage]
* If it is a small amount, it can be mixed with other burnable garbage.

Clothing (all fabric items are eligible) Paper waste

Cigarette butts Tempura scraps, used tempura oil, meat fat (solidify with a coagulant)

Ropes Wood chips (length 50cm or less)

Non-burnable garbage

Weeks 2 and 4
Thursday

Spray cans (please poke a hole in them after using them up) Leather products

Pottery Rubber

Metals Glass

Items not collected in the village

I have a request

Home appliances eligible for recycling

Televisions, washing machines, refrigerators, freezers, and air conditioners: Please return them to the store where you purchased them, or to an appliance collection service in the village or Kutchan town.

waste tires (including wheels)

To designated participating stores such as gas stations and tire shops. Fees vary depending on size, etc.

Agricultural waste plastic

Greenhouses, tunnels, mulch, fertilizer bags, plastic wrap, pesticide bottles

fire extinguisher

Please contact your retailer. Collection methods and fees vary by store.

Battery

Please contact your retailer. Please ask your retailer to process the waste. Please check the fees with your retailer.
